

# Training for Fire Marshals & Code Officials

## *CNG Fuel Station Safety & Inspections*

Thursday, September 21, 2017, 8:15 am - 12:15 pm, in Tulsa



### Course Description

This **free**, grant-funded course designed for fire marshals and code officials explains relevant codes and how they apply to Compressed Natural Gas (CNG) fueling stations. Participants will leave understanding the differences between **IFC**, **NFPA 52** and **NFPA 30A**.

These differences are a common source of friction between CNG developers and code officials because the industry designs meet NFPA 52, but code officials often inspect using the IFC. **This class will cut through the confusing and often conflicting parts of the codes**, and attendees will be able to enforce codes and permitting in a consistent manner that also **improves public safety**.

### About the Instructor

Jeremy Moore is the Fire Chief for Broken Arrow, and has been a professional firefighter since 1996. He holds a Bachelor's in Fire Service Management and a Master's in Public Administration, and his accreditations include **Fire Inspector** and **Fire Service Instructor** from the International Fire Service Accreditation Congress (**IFSAC**). In 2009, he completed the National Fire Academy's Executive Fire Officer Program.

Through his work with industry leaders and public officials, Chief Moore has become a national leader on safety and codes for natural gas fuel stations.
