

## SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

The Fire Marshal's Association Of Oklahoma, in an endeavor to support technical training in fire prevention and related fields, is offering a \$500.00 scholarships to individuals enrolled in an approved fire prevention curriculum. Through this program it is the Association's hope that eligible students, in need of financial assistance, will not be denied the opportunity to study and pursue a career which will contribute to a reduction in loss of life and property due to fire.

Scholarships will be offered to those students who can demonstrate a need for financial assistance, have maintained a reasonable grade point average through high school and post high school training, and who demonstrate a commitment to work toward a Fire Safe Oklahoma.

Students who are interested in this program must submit an application by August 1, 2008. The Scholarship will be awarded at the Fire Marshals Conference annual conference in August 2008. Students who considered will be notified by mail and may be requested to schedule a personal interview for additional screening.

The scholarship program is especially designed to assist those who are planning careers in fire prevention and related fields. It may be used for fall, spring or summer semesters at any accredited college. However, a student may only apply for one scholarship per calendar year.

Applicants shall submit a type written application with the following information:

**General:** Name, Date, Mailing Address, City, State, Zip Code, Telephone Number, Marital Status, Number of dependents

**Employment:** Name of employer, Full or part time, Spouse employer if applies, Combined annual income

**Educational Background:** High School, Year Graduated, Grade point average, Vocational training, College, Years completed, Grade point average, Degrees obtained if applies

**Respond to the following questions:**

Are you currently attending school?

What degree program will scholarship be used for?

What other scholarships or educational assistance currently being received?

Briefly state why you are applying for a scholarship.

Briefly state how this scholarship will assist you in promoting a fire safe Oklahoma.
